

## DEATH OF AN OLD COLONIST.

The death is announced of a very old colonist in the person of Mrs. James S. Cockman, which took place yesterday, at the residence of her grandson, Mr. Charles Truslove, of Bayswater. The deceased came to this State in the year 1829 in the ship Atwick. Mrs. Cockman was the first woman that was married in this State. Mr. Cockman took up land at Wanneroo, where he resided with his wife, and carried on farming for a great number of years. He was one of the oldest pioneers. The deceased had reached the ripe age of 94 years. She leaves two sons and five daughters to mourn their loss. The funeral is advertised to take place tomorrow (Sunday) afternoon, at 3 o'clock.
