
Death of Mr A. Hillier

A resident of the Tatiara since his infancy and since the infancy of the agricultural settlement of the district, passed away with the death of Mr Arthur Hillier, at the Tatiara Memorial Hospital on Monday, January 31. Mr Hillier was the youngest son of the late Mr and Mrs Geogre Hillier, snr., of Mundalla. He was born in Strathalbyn on November 14, 1875, and as an infant went with his parents to Kingston district, and came with them a little later to Mundalla district when they settled there, so that practically all his life of 51 years had been passed in the Tatiara. On January 16, 1907, he married the eldest daughter of Mrs and the late Mr John Weir, of Bordertown, and after his marriage resided in Bordertown for 19 years. For many years he was employed 'at Noske Bros.' Mill in Bordertown. He was a man of quiet and homely disposition, with a keen interest in his garden. The funeral took place on Tuesday, February 1, in Bordertown cemetery, and a large funeral cortege followed him to the grave where the service was performed by Pastor F. Cornelius. He leaves a widow and two daughters, and one child pre-deceased him.
