Death of Mrs. Elizabeth Lawrence

On Saturday last Mrs. Elizabeth Lawrence, relict of the late Henry Lawrence, died at Fermoy private hospital after a lengthy illness. Th. deceased lady was born in County Tyronn, Ireland, on November 8, 1838, and was therefore nearly 77 years of age. In 1859 she came to this State in the ship "West Australia" and upon arrival proceeded to the Eastern Districts, where she remained for about 56 years. In 1861 she married the late Mr. Henry Lawrence, the ceremony being performed in the Middle Swan Shortly after their marriage church. they rented a farm from the late Mr. S. W. Viveash, at Yarramony, and lived there for nearly 34 years, and experienced all the hardships common to pioneers. In 1898 they purchas d Rock Vale Estate, and the deceased lady resided there with her son, Mr. R. Lawrence, up to the time of her demise. Her husband pre-deceased her some live year ago. A family of four sons, Messrs. W. H., R., S. J. and A. A. Lawrence, and two daughters, Mesdam-'es J. T. Griffin (Toodyay), and K. B. Rose (Minnievale), survive her. There are also thirty grandchildren and one great grandchild. The funeral took place on Sunday afternoon and was largely attended by representatives from all parts of the district. The cortege proceeded to St. John's church, and thence to the Anglican portion of the Northam cemetery, where the interment took place, the Rev. A. L. Marshall officiating at the graveside.
