LATE MRS ELLEN E. BEAVIS

The death occurred at the Northam Hospital on Monday last of Mrs Ellen Elizabeth Beavis at the age of 68 years. The deceased lady was the wife of Mr William Beavis, of 30 Fitzgerald-street, Northam. She was born at Southampton, W.A. and was married at Geraldton in 1898. From Geraldton the family went to Victoria, and spent a number of years there, coming to Northam in 1916. They have lived here ever since. In addition to her husband the late Mrs Beavis is survived by two daughters, Mrs L. G. Lucy (Northam) and Mrs E. J. Barnes (Subiaco), and three sons, Messrs C. T., R. H. and H. E. Beavis, all of Northam. There are 19 grandchildren living and one great grand-child. Mr and Mrs Beavis would have celebrated the 50th anniversary of their wedding on August 24.

The funeral took place at 3 o'clock on Tuesday afternoon, when an impressive service was conducted at the Methodist Church by the Rev. S. H. Siggers.
