Lieut. GWYNN'S Troop which stormed the rocky ridge west  
of SABA. He was in charge of a troop Hotchkiss gun, with  
which weapon he did considerable damage amongst  
the enemy. During the pursuit at daylight on the  
30th he galloped his gun forward, in close quarters, brought  
it into action and shot the teams of a leading field gun  
horses, causing its abandonment by the enemy. SARGE  
showed conspicuous gallantry and dash throughout the  
whole of these operations.

Trooper GREEN has displayed great bravery on several  
occasions during the recent operations. He was one of the  
advance party which forced its way over the JORDAN above  
TISR BENAT YAKUB on 27.9.18 in the face of heavy machine  
gun rifle fire. Trooper VINEASH was mortally wounded  
when Trooper GREEN, utterly disregarding his own personal  
safety carried VINEASH under cover, rendered first aid  
and then continued on his task. On 30.9.18 he reconnoitred at great personal  
risk the enemy position and gave information which  
led to the final routing of the German rearguard. Again  
on 1.10.18 in opposition against the enemy rearguard at DUMA  
on the DAMASCUS-ALLEPPO road, GREEN was in the forefront  
of the Squadron's attack, throughout, where, by his personal  
bravery and dash, he did much towards the final capture  
of the enemy rear guard.

Trooper EDWARDS who was in charge of his troop Hotchkiss gun  
did magnificent work during the crossing of the JORDAN on the  
evening of 27.9.18. Pushing his team across the ford he advanced  
his gun into a position from which he got flanking fire on the  
enemy machine gun, causing the ford and put it out of action.  
EDWARDS despatched work in the early morning of 30.9.18  
when, by his dash and quickness in pushing forward with his gun  
he did much to prevent the enemy taking up rearguard positions.  
Again on 1.10.18 near DUMA, EDWARDS with his gun formed part of the right  
flank guard, and by his initiative in pushing forward he succeeded in  
capturing a German machine gun with a crew of 6 and horses.
