

## **Death Of Mrs. M. M. Martin**

A very old identity of Northam and district, Mrs. Margaret Mary Martin, died at the Northam Hospital on April 29, at the age of 89 years. She was the widow of the late John Martin, well-known farmer of Seabrook, who was a member of the Northam Road Board for many years.

Mr. and Mrs. Martin retired from their farm in 1929, when they came in to Northam and lived at "Glenisla", Doctor's Hill. The late Mrs. Martin was a very staunch supporter of the late Sir James Mitchell throughout his political career, and an active member of the Liberal Party, both at Seabrook and in Northam. She was also a keen supporter of the Northam Agricultural Society.

The deceased lady was notable for her interest in public affairs right up to the time of her death and in spite of her illness extending over several months. She leaves two sons, Messrs. Cecil and Clarence Martin, and one daughter, Mrs. Mabel Stempel.

The funeral, which was private, took place on Saturday April 30.
