Some additional notes on Henry Maddock compliments of Colleen Ranger

Parents: His father's name was James MADDOCK (and spelling variations – MADDICK, MATTOCK etc). I know the death certificate lists the father's name as Percy James MADDOCK; that is incorrect. Henry Jesse MADDOCK's son was Percival Ernest Allen MADDOCK; perhaps the death certificate informant got mixed up.

James MADDOCK married Jane SMITH 11th Sep 1810

From Devon OPC Transcript

CLAYHIDON Banns fiche 11 page 9 no 44 James Mattock bachelor of this parish and Jane Smith spinster of the same 19th Aug, 26th Aug, 2nd Sep 1810; St Andrew's, Clayhidon. CLAYHIDON MARRIAGES; fiche 12 page 11 no 44 James Mattock bachelor of this parish and Jane Smith were married by banns this eleventh day of September 1810. Bride and groom made mark. Witnesses: George Poole and Anne Woodrow.

Clayhidon was Jane Smith's parish

James MADDOCK died 13th Mar 1843 in Payhembury and is buried in the churchyard.

Jane MADDOCK married to Simon COLLARD 31st Oct 1848 in Uffculme – where Jane had moved – to be with her daughter Charlotte APLIN, nee MADDOCK.

Jane died in Uffculme in 1863.

Jane Collard (Henry Jesse MADDOCK'S mother) visited Henry in gaol before he was transported to Western Australia.

Marriage

Henry Jesse MADDOCK did indeed marry the person called Mary Ann ALLEN. However Mary Ann's birth name was Mary Ann GARNISH, born Chichester 1848, illegitimate daughter of Frances GARNISH. Frances married Joseph ALLEN in Chelsea, Middlesex in 1853; Frances' 3 illegitimate children assumed the surname ALLEN at that time and the combined family (with Joseph's daughter Elizabeth ALLEN) emigrated to Western Australia per 'Clara' in 1853.
